La Carrolla (1948 – 2015) IS 67 Wears old

In most high schools in the world there is a student newspaper written and edited by the students themselves.

It often consists in 4 pages (A3 size) and tells about school life humorously. The editor is usually a bright student who is supported by 4 reporters. Sometimes also a teacher can contribute and a teacher may be detailed by the school Headmaster to supervise the paper without interfering. When the school is culturally alive, the articles are interesting and provocative.

The paper is read by students and teachers alike, though for different reasons. There are humorous sketches that are not usually liked by the teacher or by the student they refer to

The issues of the paper are often collected in the school archive as they can contribute to tell the story of the school as seen bu the students in a humorous way.

In 1948 (fonaccording toi: Com.ti Sergio Girardini and Amedeo Cassano, 1932 class), a group of students of Istituto Tecnico Nautico "San Giorgio" of Genoa decided to publish a student newspaper which they named "La Carretta".(1), with the consent of the headmaster prof. Ing. Guglielmo Levi.

The newspaper was well liked by the students as well as by the teachers. The articles were about working at sea and shipping in general It also dealt with school problems.

Its publication continued up to the late sixties

The "Associazione ex allievi e docenti dell' Istituto Tecnico Nautico S. Giorgio" revived it in December 1989. Since then, it has been - and still is - distributed to all the Association members The articles and the news are written by former students and former teachers of the school It would be great if the school students would take it up over again.

⁽¹⁾ A *carretta* (*tramp*) is a vessel that can be compared to an old cart pulled by a donkey, an old vessel, surely not a 'Ferrari' of the seas



Open letter

Ing. Francesco Giuseppe Boero (BAUER)
(abridged)

Dear All,

As you know, I am a former student of Nautico San Giorgio (I got my diploma 51 years ago) and a former President of our Association.

Since I went on to the university getting a degree in Engineering and I worked for Comune di Genova for 36 years, I spent little time at sea and I rarely dealt with the problems of the maritime world though the sea has always remained in my heart.

I regularly attend the San Giorgio Awards Ceremony. I was moved by the students of Nautico and of the Academy standing in the Salone delle compere of Palazzo S.Giorgio. The ones who received a prize were visibly happy and proud



The organization was perfect.

Unfortunately I was under the impression that our Association was barely tolerated even though we have always actively contributed to the success of the event. It is not the first time that I get this feeling and I am afraid that someone would like to exclude us from the event organization.

I do, however, hope that in the future we will be more appreciated and not just tolerated and won't be 'kicked out'.

During the ceremony the most frequent word used by the speakers was 'path': teaching path, legislative path and especially learning path.

I believe that the young generations should be equipped by the school and by the university with the tools required to enter the seafaring world with adequate skills and competence and that they should be offered a really sound path of life-long education.

There is a lot of talk about the 'laurea di 1° livello' (a three-year bachelor degree). They say that there is a need for engineers onboard but, as far as I know, the engineers coming straight out of the university are not really equipped to run a ship efficiently since the current learning/teaching/training path is not tailored to the actual professional needs of the seafarers. It takes much more to make skilled and competent Officers..

Clearly things are different for Naval Architects and students of Logistics (a new course which excites some curiosity). There already are well established university courses for them.

All the speakers at the ceremony praised the prize-winners but no one told them and the ship-owners present that more, much more, should be done. What a wasted opportunity!
